1) Public Comment

Members of the public were given the opportunity to directly address the Committee on any item listed on the agenda.

Thomas White and Robbie Anderson provided input on both agenda items.

2) Request for Renewal of the Agreement for Use of the Likeness of the City Shield by Universal Studios Singapore Theme Park

- Universal Studios Singapore Theme Park requested to renew its agreement for use of the likeness of the Beverly Hills Shield in the Park's "Welcome to Far Far Away" signage.
- Universal Studios Singapore is interested in a renewal of an existing licensing agreement for use of the likeness of the City Shield. The current licensing agreement with Universal Studios Singapore began on January 1, 2010 for a duration of 10 years and will expire on December 31, 2020. The annual license fee in the agreement for use of the likeness of the City Shield is \$3,000 due each year.
- Staff requested direction regarding whether or not to increase the annual license fee and renew the license agreement for an additional 10-year duration. Council liaisons reviewed the proposal and approved to provide staff with the following direction:
 - Negotiate an increase to the permission fee with Universal Studios Singapore with an initial ask of \$10,000 annually for 10 years as well as request a discount on park admission for Beverly Hills residents.
 - If the initial ask is not approved in whole or in part, staff has the ability to approve \$5,000 per year for the first 5 years with a consumer price index adjustment annually for the second 5 years and remove the discount on park admission request for Beverly Hills residents.
 - If neither offer is approved, allow the license agreement to expire on December 31, 2020 and not renew at the existing rate of \$3,000 annually for 10 years.
- If Universal Studios Singapore agrees to one of the renewal proposals, the agreed upon negotiated terms will be presented to the full City Council for approval at a regularly scheduled City Council meeting. The City Attorney's Office reviewed the request for renewal from Universal Studios Singapore Theme Park.
